1. **Venue:** Uzbekistan, Tashkent, “JAR” sport complex

2. **Dates:** 5-9 October 2008

3. **Schedule:**

5 October – arrival, mandate commission, weigh-in
- ASF Congress

6 October – Asian Championship amongst youth (female/male, birth years 1990-1991)

7 October – Asian Championship amongst juniors (female/male, birth years 1988-1989)

8 October – Asian Championship amongst seniors (female/male)
- Asian Championship on Combat SAMBO (senior male)

9 October - Departure

4. **Weight categories:**

Youth (female) – 40, 44, 48, 52, 56, 60, 65, 70, 75, +75

Youth (male) – 48, 52, 56, 60, 65, 70, 75, 81, 87, + 87

Juniors (female) – 44, 48, 52, 56, 60, 64, 68, 72, 80, +80

Juniors (male) – 48, 52, 57, 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, + 100

Female (seniors) – 48, 52, 56, 60, 64, 68, 72, 80, +80

Male (seniors) – 52, 57, 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, + 100

Combat SAMBO (senior male) – 52, 57, 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, + 100

5. **General conditions:**

- Competitions are organized by Asian SAMBO Federation and SAMBO Federation of Uzbekistan according to FIAS calendar
- Competitions are open for participation of any National SAMBO Federation – FIAS member regardless of continental membership
- Every sportsman must present his/her medical certificate to compete
- All members of delegations must have medical insurance
- Organizing committee guarantees first aid to all members of delegations

- Teams must provide Organizing committee with National anthem (on CD disc)
- Applications confirming participation and teams compositions must be provided to Organizing committee **by 15 September 2008** according to the following format:

- Delegations of countries that have visa regime with Uzbekistan must provide passport copies of every delegation member attached to the application **by 15 September 2008**

6. Financial conditions:

- Every member of national official delegation must pay 35 US dollars per day (includes board and lodging, transportation between hotel and competition venue)
- Heads of delegations must settle all financial commitments with the Organizing committee on arrival day and fulfill accreditation requirements.

7. Awarding and official ceremony:

Prizewinners are awarded with medals, diplomas and cups. The National anthem shall be performed and national flag shall be raised to honor champions.

8. Competition rules:

Competitions will be governed by the rules and regulations of FIAS
