**Regulations on World Sambo Championship
among youth (boys and girls) and juniors (boys and girls),
within 7-11 October 2010, the city of Tbilisi (Georgia).**

1. General

1.1. World Championship is held in accordance with applicable Sambo rules and FIAS Regulations.

1.2. World Championship will be organized and conducted by the National Georgian Federation of Sambo and of FIAS.

World Championship is held to:

- promote and develop Sambo in Georgia and Worldwide.
- strengthen the international sports relations.

2. Date and venue

2.1. World Championship will be held from 7 to 11 October 2010 in Tbilisi (Georgia).

3. Terms of participation

3.1. Only athletes of National Sambo Federations affiliated to FIAS who paid the annual fee to FIAS are admitted to participate in the Event. The athletes must have license books on their hands with record of paid sport license for 2010

3.4. In order to obtain visa, The National Sambo Federations must submit the List of its delegates, containing the following data: names, surnames, patronymic name, date of birth, passport number, place of work or study, position, date of arrival and departure. The copy of the passport of each participant shall be provided.

4. Technical terms

4.1. Weight categories:

4.2. World Championship Organizing Committee ensures the first medical aid to all the participants of sports delegations

4.3. All members of delegations should have medical insurance.

4.4. Team leaders (supervisors) are required to submit the following documents for the accreditation procedure:

- Application, indicating weight categories of participants
- Passport, proving the identity of participant
- License book with a record of paid annual sports license
- State flag and a record with a national anthem of a country.

5. Financial terms

5.1. The amount of fee to the Organizing Committee of the World Championship is **\$90 USD (ninety dollars of USA) per person per day.**

5.2. The amount of fee for transfer "Airport-hotel-sports venue and back" is **\$ 20 USD (twenty U.S. dollars) for 1 (one) person**, to be paid once.

5.3. All financial issues should be solved by Heads of delegations with the Organizing Committee of the World Championship during the arrival day.

5.4. Organizing Committee of the World Championship would cover the expenses for accommodation, catering and ground transportation within the period from 7 to 11 October 2010 of the following delegates:

- FIAS President
- Secretary General of FIAS
- Chairman of the FIAS referee's board (judicial commission)
- the Chief Judge of competitions
- the Chief Secretary of competitions
- 20 identified judges for refereeing World Championship

5.4.5. Organizing Committee of the World Championship would cover the expenses for transportation to Tbilisi city (Georgia) and back (by plane or train) of the following delegates:

- Chairman of the FIAS referee's board (judicial commission)
- the Chief Judge of competitions
- the Chief Secretary of competitions

6. Awarding ceremony

6.1. Athletes who took the prize-winning places are awarded with medals, cups and diplomas.

7. Official ceremonies

7.1. Participants of the World Championship have to take part in all official ceremonies.

7.2. In honor of the winners the national anthems of countries will be played and the national flags would be raised.

8. Visa

8.1. The entrance visa to Georgia can be obtained at the airport of Tbilisi or at the Georgian Consulate in your country.
